■■■■ Course Description

A continuing education course reviewing out-of-hospital childbirth to include normal and complicated deliveries. Emphasis is placed on recognizing and managing typical and atypical vaginally deliverable positions of the neonate, as well as critical conditions during delivery such as prolapsed cord, placenta previa and abruption, neonatal resuscitation, and maternal hemorrhage.

You will recognize non-vaginally deliverable positions and their management. Students will also be able to recognize normal and critical conditions of both the mother and the neonate during delivery and in the immediate postpartum time frame (once the neonate is delivered). Review management tools and assessment skills available to EMS providers in a challenging rural setting with increasingly limited access to OB, NICU/PICU, and surgical resources.
